IndiGoReach "Giving Wings to Fly" Scholarship Programme

Eligible **female students** are invited to apply for the **IndiGoReach "Giving Wings to Fly" Scholarship Programme** for pursuing **Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL)** training.

Eligibility:

1. Female candidates aged **18–35 years**.
2. Passed Class XII with **English, Physics and Mathematics**, securing at least **51% marks in each subject**.
3. Belong to an **EWS-eligible economically disadvantaged household**.
4. Possess a valid Indian passport or have initiated the passport application before Phase 3.

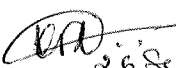
Last date to apply: 31 October 2026

Interested and eligible students are encouraged to apply through the scholarship registration portal and explore this opportunity to pursue a career in aviation.

In view of the above, all AICTE-affiliated institutions are requested to:

1. Disseminate the attached programme brochure among eligible girl students through institutional communication channels, placement and training cells, career guidance centers, student groups, and social media platforms.
2. Encourage eligible girl students who have studied Physics, Mathematics, and English in Class XII to apply for the scholarship programme.
3. Nominate interested girl students to participate in the programme awareness sessions being organized by CSRBOX Group in collaboration with IndiGoReach to facilitate better understanding of the programme, eligibility criteria, selection process, and career opportunities in aviation.
4. Considering that the selection process may take approximately 3-4 months or longer, the programme is more suitable for Final-year students. Accordingly, applicants are advised to ensure that their academic commitments are compatible with the prescribed training schedule before applying.
5. Institutions interested in organizing an awareness session are requested to fill out the attached Google Form and share their preferred mode (online/offline) and schedule. Since the last date for Phase-II scholarship applications is 31st October, 2026, institutions are requested to submit their session requirements through the Google Form <https://forms.gle/vACRXAoy7BTrVT3aA> by 10th October, 2026.
