"CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEME OF POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR ST STUDENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25.

The Directorate of Tribal Welfare is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, New Delhi namely:

The Scheme of "Post Matric Scholarship (Centrally Sponsored Scheme) to grant scholarship to eligible ST students for pursuing higher education starting from XI to Post Graduation course in India. Students are hereby informed that those who wish to apply for the above scheme for "FRESH AND RENEWAL APPLICATIONS" shall apply for the same through the National Scholarship Portal (http://scholarships.gov.in) which is an online site for the said scholarship.

OBJECTIVE:

To enable eligible Scheduled Tribes students to undertake quality education from Post Matric to Post Graduate level by providing them financial assistance.

Conditions of Eligibility.

- 1. The Student should belong to Scheduled Tribe so specified in relation to the State/Union Territory to which he/she actually belongs (Domicile State).
- 2. Student should have passed Matriculation or Higher Secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education.
- 3. The Family income of student from all sources should not exceed more than Rs. 2, 50,000/-p.a.
- 4. The Student should have a valid account in as Schedule Bank linked with Aadhar and Mobile number.
- 5. The student should not be getting any other scholarship.
- 6. The scholarships will be given for study recognized post-matriculation/postsecondary courses, recognized by the concern approving authority, pursued in the following category of Institutions/Universities/Colleges.

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BE UPLOADED ON THE PORTAL.

- 1. Income Certificate issued by competent authority of the year 2023-24.
- 2. Fee receipt of current academic year.

- 3. Scheduled Tribes Certificate issued by competent authority.
- 4. Scanned copy of the last academic year Marksheet/certificate.
- 5. Hostel Certificate for Hosteller students.
- 6. Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority designated District Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon of Govt. Hospital for Disable st
- 7. Bonafide Certificate from Institute which is uploaded on the Portal.

All the above documents shall be scanned uploaded on the National Scholarship Portal; size should be less than **200KB in PDF/JPEG format**.

Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Mission has issued following directions for compliance:

- a) Aadhar to be made mandatory for all applicants.
- b) Aadhar based bio-metric authentication and eKYC has been made mandatory from 2024-25.
- c) All scholarship payments to be made using Aadhar Payment Bridge (APB) system to ensure that payments are made only to the rightful beneficiary. Students have to seed their bank account with their Aadhar number so that they can receive the scholarship benefit in their bank account. Bank details will no longer be captured on the NSP portal.

The above conditions will be applicable for both Fresh & Renewal.

In renewal also, students should submit their application after completing their OTP based eKYC. Applications will not be submitted with Aadhar based eKYC.

Further, NSP has introduced face-authentication from the academic year 2024-25. The following points are conveyed for compliance on the National Scholarship Portal.

- The Portal is open for One Time Registration (OTR) for students.
- One Time Registration (OTR) is a unique number allotted to the student and is applicable for the entire Academic career on National Scholarship Portal.
- OTR is required to apply for the scholarship on National Scholarship Portal from AY 2024-25.
- OTR can be generated using Aadhar / Aadhar Enrollment number (EID).
- The Students who have applied on National Scholarship Portal in AY 2023-24 will be allotted the OTR/ Reference number through the portal and intimated through SMS. For more details please.
- NSP OTR App is available on Google Play Store.

FOR FRESH REGISTRATION THE PROCEDURE IS:

1. Go to <u>www.scholarship.gov.in</u> ⇒ Home⇒ Students ⇒ OTR⇒Login⇒Register yourself ⇒ then follow the instruction.

FOR RENEWAL REGISTRATION THE PROCEDURE IS:

1. Go to <u>www.scholarship.gov.in</u> ⇒ Enter your **OTR No** ⇒ Password ⇒ and then proceed with the Login.

Students take a note that after submitting all the valid documents get the print of the application and the documents to the College Administration Office on or before the 31st December 2024.
