NOTICE

AICTE YASHASVI (Young Achiever's Scholarship and Holistic Academic Skills Venture Initiative) Scheme

A scholarship scheme from AICTE for meritorious students seeking admission in core branches of Engineering in order to motivate students to pursue engineering education at Diploma and UG level in the core branches of engineering. The main objective of the scheme is to encourage students to pursue technical education in core branches of engineering i.e. Civil, Electronic and Mechanical Engineering in AICTE approved technical institutions.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1) The candidate should be admitted to First year of Degree/ Diploma level course in any of the AICTE approved institutions of respective year.
- 2) The Candidate total family income must not exceed ₹8 lakh per annum.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

- 1) The candidate fulfilling the eligibility conditions is required to apply through the AICTE Yashasvi Scholarship Portal at : <https://yashasvi.aicte.gov.in/login.php>
- 2) The host institution where the candidate is studying required verifying the online application.

CRITERIA OF SELECTION:

- 1) The selection of candidate will be carried out solely on the basis of the merit of qualifying qualification (12th grade) to pursue the Technical Degree Core branch of Engineering from any of the AICTE approved institutions.
- 2) Selection of candidates under lateral entry will be on the basis of average consolidated percentage of Marks in all 6 semesters. Limited to 10% of total seats allocation in respective states.
- 3) In case the number of scholarships per state wise allotment below 10 as per the calculation, Competent Authority approved to ascertain minimum 10 number of scholarship in the state.
- 4) State/UT wise merit list will be prepared as per number of scholarships allotted in the point number 3.0 above.

RESERVATION:

As per Government of India norms.


RENEWALS:

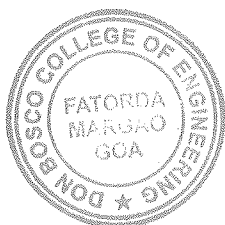
- 1) The scholarship will be renewed for the next year of study on receipt of renewal through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) by submitting passing certificate/ mark sheet along with letter from the Head of the Institution on the online portal.
- 2) Student failing to get promoted to the next class/ level would forfeit the scholarship.


TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The gap period between the year of passing the qualifying examination and the session of admission in degree/ diploma course should not be more than two years.
2. Applications will be invited once in a year through National e-Scholarship Portal Scholarship Portal of the Government of India.
3. If a student is in reserved category and also qualified in General Category merit list of scholarship, then he/she will be counted under the General Category.
4. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. Only verified online applications will be considered for the award of scholarship.
5. If a candidate drops out in subsequent year, he/she will not be eligible for further scholarship.
6. Since the scholarship is meant for core engineering branches, if a candidate shifts to any other branch from aforesaid CCEEM programmes in any subsequent year, he/she will not be eligible for scholarship and will have to refund entire amount of scholarship to AICTE by Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Member Secretary, AICTE" payable at New Delhi.
7. The grant of scholarship is subject to the condition that the student does not receive any financial assistance in shape of scholarship/any emoluments, salary, stipend etc. from any other source during his/her course of study in the Institute. In case of receipt of any financial assistance from any other sources, the scholarship shall be discontinued and the entire amount of scholarship will have to be refunded to AICTE by D/Draft drawn in favour of "Member Secretary, AICTE" payable at New Delhi.
8. Scheme will be implemented and monitored by the AICTE.
9. For converting Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) to percentage, multiplying factor will be 9.5 i.e. to convert the CGPA into percentage; $CGPA \times 9.5$ will give the percentage.
10. In case both CGPA & total marks are given in the mark sheet, total marks will be.
11. If grades are given like A1, A2, B1, B2 etc. in the mark sheet, first the grades will be converted into CGPA and then average CGPA will be calculated. This CGPA will be converted into percentage as given in point No. 8.
12. Provisional list of shortlisted candidates will be uploaded on the AICTE web portal. In case, candidate has any query about merit list of scholarship, they may raise their grievances within a month. No query regarding merit list will be entertained after one-month duration from the date of publishing of merit list on AICTE website. Query regarding non-payment of the scholarship due to invalid/ wrong account number will be entertained only up to six months from the date of publishing of merit list on AICTE website.
